## Pictures being posted on the ARHA Website

Starting immediately for all hunts held from July 1<sup>st</sup> 2023 on, we will now offer listing individual club results with pictures on our ARHA website. We are going back to July 1<sup>st</sup> since this was when the Rabbit Hunter magazine was no longer available. To have pictures listed online there are guidelines that clubs will have to follow. Listed below are the guidelines we are going to use. We have explained below about labeling the pictures, this is something that has to be done. At the NKC office we talk to some of you a lot but we never have seen most of you and have no way of knowing who the person in the picture is or what dog is in the picture. So, if the pictures are not labeled, we will not know who you are or who the dog is. Some of the guidelines may seem redundant or useless but if we don't have correct information sent in, the wrong information will be listed online. We will not go back and continually make changes to names that were sent in wrong or spelled wrong. This will be a work in progress for a while and it may take a little while to get everything finalized. We have also added pictures of the 2023 winners of the Little Pack World Hunt and winners of the Progressive Pack US to their individual web pages, those pictures will remain online until the following year when the new winner's pictures will be added.

- 1. All pictures need to be sent to <u>contactus@arha.com</u>.
- 2. We will post up to 10 pictures for a club hunt and up to 20 pictures for State or Big hunts. The Little Pack World and Progressive Pack US will depend on the number of pictures taken at the banquet & Hunts.
- 3. All Pictures must be emailed in the NKC office. The pictures must be sent as an attachment and not embedded in the email.
- 4. The pictures need to be emailed in with in 2 weeks of the hunt date. Clubs do not need to hold pictures from several hunts and then send them in at one time. This only makes it harder for the Person sending the pictures in and the NKC office trying to figure out all of the pictures.
- 5. All pictures need to be taken in the same direction (either all landscape or all portrait) and the pictures need to be the same size.
- 6. If pictures include dog food other than Purina Dog food, those pictures will not be used.
- 7. The email must have the Name of the Club the pictures are from, date of the hunt and list if they are for a club or other type of event.
- 8. All pictures **MUST BE** labeled in the email with the dog's name, either placement in hunt or what the pictures is of and who is in the picture the owner/handler. We will list the names included in the email. The person sending the email in **MUST** make sure all names are spelled correctly as the information included in the email is what we will use to label the pictures.
- 9. If multiple emails are sent in at the same time with the pictures attached, all of the emails must have the information for the pictures in that email.
- 10. The ARHA office will not contact the club for information on who is in a picture if not labeled. Any pictures come in with no explanation or are not labeled, will be posted with the hunt results for that date and no other information listed. The office will not go back later to add the contact information for the pictures.
